I, Richard Murphy of Casey County and State of Kentucky, considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound and perfect mind and memory, blessed be the Almighty God for the same, do make and publish this my last Will and testament in manner and form following:

First, I recommend my body to the Earth to be buried in a decent Christian like manner and all my debts punctually paid by my Executrix and Executor.

Second, I do give and bequeath unto my beloved wife, Jane Murphy, all my real and personal estate to her own sole use and benefit during her natural life.

I do appoint Jane Murphy and Laughlan Edwards my sole Executrix and Executor to this my last Will and testament, hereby revoking all former Wills by me made.

In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventh day of October in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred & Twenty.
