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<sup>2</sup> Should it matter for some reason, these numbers may actually be family numbers rather than household numbers. We have found two sets of duplications and in each case changed the number by one to avoid the conflict. This probably resulted from differing enumeration districts.

<sup>3</sup> Also in the home of William Thomas Murphy was Agnes May, a 23 year old white female identified as the sister-in-law of the head of household (William Thomas Murphy). This would appear to make her the sister of Lillie E. Murphy, a/k/a "Lillie E. May Murphy."

<sup>4</sup> Alice Murphy, **an 18 year old**, single, white female, was living in the household of Martin Penn and Nina Sue Penn (and their five children ranging in age from 1 to 10) and was their servant.

In the 1900 Census, Alace Murphy, **a 14 year old**, single, white female, was living in the household of Abigale Shearin, a widowed 70 year old white female, as a servant. As Alace was born in the "black hole of genealogy," between 1880 and 1900, her family identity is presently unknown.

<sup>7</sup> Sam Murphey (**10 years of age**), a single white male, was living in the household of James M. Buchanan and Mary E. Buchanan. He is listed as a “hired hand” and we hope that was just to boost a little boy’s ego.

<sup>8</sup> Also in the household of Joel Stanley Murphy and Cleopatria Wade Murphy was a single **13 year old** white boy named Mart Cravins who was listed as a “hired boy.”

<sup>9</sup> Sallie E. Murphy married Raymond Tye Faulkner (Sr.) and lived in Taylor County.

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<sup>10</sup> William A. Murphy reported that he had been born in Tennessee.

<sup>11</sup> Robert Lee Murphy (this writer's great-grandfather) was born "John T. Murphy" but apparently selected his new name before his tenth birthday. His great-uncle George Riffe Murphy had died while in the 13<sup>th</sup> Kentucky Confederate Cavalry (although we are having difficulty documenting that), and we assume that he chose his name from Robert E. Lee. The "Lee" has been passed down each generation since and including to this writer, Jerry Lee Foster. Robert Lee "Bobby Lee" Murphy had Huntington's Chorea which seems to have originated with Richard Murphy (1775-1820) and to have been passed down until it finally took its last victim in the 1990's.

<sup>12</sup> Riley Ann was a Pelly (or Pelley) from Adair County, or near the Adair County line, and was named for her father who died at about the time of her birth. Her great-great-great-granddaughter, Riley Jane McCallum, is named for her.

<sup>13</sup> Edna Lee Murphy married Willie Moss Watkins.

<sup>14</sup> Robert Preston Murphy (named for his grandfather) was killed in an automobile collision before it was determined whether or not he might have had Huntington's. "Aunt Lizzie" (Elizabeth Gather Murphy) married Walter Bryan Moser. She had Huntington's and one of two her children inherited it.

<sup>15</sup> "Uncle Jim" Watkins (named for two of his uncles) married Lorene Griffin from Casey County and they lived in Louisville. He had Huntington's Chorea, and his two sons both inherited the disease.

<sup>19</sup> Also in the Thomas Murphy household was Green Earles, (49), a widowed white male designated as father-in-law of Thomas Murphy. Therefore, Anna had been an Earles.

Murphy, and his wife, Minnie E. Bell Murphy, and their daughter, Margarete E. Murphy (later in life to wed William Wolfe and live and die in Louisville, Kentucky), were residing with her. Also in the household was an unrelated single, black hired man named Lillome M. Wilkinson, born in Kentucky. "Sallie" was the great-great-grandmother of this editor, Jerry L. Foster (7<sup>th</sup> generation Casey Countian), and this family property is currently held by this writer, hopefully to be passed on to the 10<sup>th</sup> generation.

<sup>21</sup> John Murphy was a widower who was supporting his two daughters (30 and 15) and also a one year old white female named Mary F. Hicks and designated as his granddaughter.
